The Golf Executive of the Year Award is given to a golf professional who performed outstanding services for a multi facility operation as an executive manager for at least 3 years, has a substantial record of service to the Association as well as help in educating in support of innovation and player development, is regarded as a model PGA Member possessing outstanding qualities of leadership, vision, courage and strong moral character and has developed an image and reputation with the ability to inspire fellow PGA Professionals. I believe that I embody these traits in the following ways:

- Executive Manager at a multi facility operation Now in my 17th year at Treetops, I've worked my way from Head Professional to Director of Golf to my current position as Assistant General Manager. Our 81 holes span two distinct facilities and my oversight is now over all aspects of the operation. Treetops has flourished in the past 10 years as my role has gotten larger with the resort as evidenced by the extensive capital improvements taking place in the last few years.
- Level of Service to our Section and Association I have served concurrently for the past 16 years at all levels including all officer chairs with the Northern Chapter of the Michigan Section, at large board position, committee positions, Secretary and Vice President of the Michigan Section and sat on the Inclusion Committee and Special Awards Committee for the PGA of America. Some highlights of my service include enhancing the MI PGA Hall of Fame process as chairman of that committee for two years, authored and delivered a Michigan Section Orientation program at chapter meetings and Ferris State University, making significant changes to the Michigan PGA Constitution and assisting in creating the job scope for Michigan Section's first Player Development Coordinator. I've also been active in bringing all PGA promoted player development programs to Treetops including being the first facility in the state to have an in house PGA Junior League. We consistently have more than 40 kids and topped out at a record 61 kids in 2021.
