## NMPGA 2022 Fall Report

- Thanks to the Board, Scott Ashley, Scott Wilson, and Brandon Dean
- Player Sponsorships – (Calling it a Banner Sponsor moving forward)
  - o 6 Player Sponsorships
    - \$500
      - Player permit paid for
      - 1 point towards Chapter Championship
      - \$375 split between Pro-Ams and Chapter Championship
    - o Starting to gain more interest as people figure out what it is and how it works
- NMPGA Tournament Schedule re-cap
  - o 10 Pro-Ams
    - Average 22 teams per Pro-Am
- Chapter Championship Re-Structure
  - o From 3 days to 2
    - Pro-Am is round 1 of Chapter on Monday w/ Shootout in the afternoon
    - Round 2-3 on Tuesday (Possible to go to just 18 holes on Tuesday)
    - Added 7 more players (29) in the Championship
    - Almost doubled the size of the Pro-Am
  - o Reasons for Re-structure
    - Different Pressures and Priorities make it difficult to play
      - Less time away
      - Still playing for a great purse (2022 approx. 22K)
- Good Financial shape moving into 2023
  - o Carrying over a balance of \$2450
- Working on a NMPGA Pro-Am “Major/Major”
  - o Bay Harbor – 27 holes w/ entry to be \$900 per team (\$300 per Am)
    - Pro plays at N/C
    - Tournament favor
    - Lunch included at the turn
    - Post party across the street at the new High Five Distillery (Gypsy Vodka)
