In 2010, as President of the Michigan PGA, I had the purview to establish committees. I felt it was important the Michigan PGA lead by example with Patriot Golf Day, as the genesis of the foundation was here in Michigan. I established the Patriot Golf Day Committee. Up to that point my facility was not really engaged in supporting the event or foundation. I decided that in order to raise awareness that I would play a golf marathon on the Sunday of Labor Day weekend, with the goal being 100 holes. That first year I played 126 holes and raised \$3,000. Since that time I have continued to increase the number of holes until 2020 when I played 234 holes and raised \$8000. Last year, 2021 I played 202 holes and raised over \$20,000.
