- The WMPGA Board held a meeting on September 26 to discuss the 2022 year. Items that were discussed included, but not limited to:
 - Pro-Am entry Fees
 - No change forecasted for 2023 (\$450 per team)
 - 2023 Chapter Championship host site to be Kent Country Club
 - 2023 Match Play tournament – changes to qualifying process and tournament structure are being worked on
 - Registration will open for all events in 2023 will open the day after the Spring Meeting.
 - We will continue to focus on creating the best possible experience at all of our pro-ams and intend to increase the payout structure for these tournaments to better reward the amateurs and professionals who play well.
- We played our Chapter Championship on September 19th at Muskegon Country Club. We had 25 players qualify for this year's Chapter Championship with Matt Thompson winning the event. After the Championship we held our fall meeting at which point there was a motion and vote to return the Championship to a 1-day, 36-hole event in the hopes of boosting participation.
