- **Player Sponsorships – (Calling it a Banner Sponsor moving forward)**
 - o \$500
 - Player Permit paid for
 - 1 point towards Chapter Championship
 - \$375 into Chapter Championship
 - o This \$ will be to supplement the Chapter Host for sponsorship
- **NMPGA Tournament Schedule**
 - o 10 Pro-Ams Scheduled
 - o 2 Pro-Pros
 - o Increasing prices of Pro-Ams to \$360 for non-majors and \$420 for majors and \$240 for Hidden River.
 - More rev for the courses that host pro-ams.
- **Chapter Championship Discussion for Spring Mtng**
 - o Looking at Tullymore and St. Ives for 2023 Chapter Champ
