In 9 years at The Fortress, we have substantially grown teaching and club fitting with the design of our indoor studio, which I designed in 2018. I teach over 1,000 lessons per year as the Head Golf Professional, utilizing Trackman, Flightscope, Blast Motion, and the Titleist Performance Institute. In my first position at The Boyne Golf Academy at King Par, I doubled lesson revenue by developing long term instructional programs.

As Chairman of the Ferris State University Professional Golf Management Advisory Board, I have made it a goal to give back as much as possible to the program. Every year since being elected to membership, one of my goals is to build a stronger relationship with the active students in the PGA program. Each year, sometimes twice, I head to Big Rapids to conduct seminars for the students on teaching and coaching, including different aspects including statistical analytics, teaching juniors, adult player development, basic ball flight laws, and teaching seniors. The Fortress has taken a total of 4 interns, Javen Howes, Maxwell Wilhelm, Suzy Gietl, and Mike Rumsey.
