The Michigan PGA Section will conduct the third annual Operation: Hero Challenge aimed to benefit Michigan PGA HOPE (Helping our Patriots Everywhere).















WHO WILL BE INVOLVED IN THE EVENT?

Two PGA HOPE Michigan Graduates will team up to compete in the second annual Operation: Hero Challenge.

WHERE WILL THE EVENT BE HOSTED?

Bedford Valley Golf Course in Battle Creek, MI

WHEN IS THE EVENT?

September 18, 2025 8:30 am - Registration & Warm Up

9:45 am - Welcome Ceremony

10:00 am - 18-Hole Shotgun

3:00 pm - Lunch & Awards Ceremony

WHAT DOES THE OPERATION: HERO CHALLENGE CONSIST OF?

Participants will play a 18-hole round with their partner and another team. During the round, there will be three different stations where teams compete to accumulate the most points in a skills competition on challenges featuring the three fundamental skills utilized in golf: driving, chipping, and putting.

WHY IS THE MICHIGAN PGA SECTION HOSTING THIS EVENT?

The goal of this event is to support our PGA HOPE programs in Michigan and foster new locations as we continue expanding our effort of growing the game of golf and serving our Veteran population.

HOW CAN I GET INVOLVED?

We are looking for 60 two-person teams of PGA HOPE Graduates to field the Operation: Hero Challenge. Each participant will be tasked to recruit pledges for their team and/or gaining flat donations to support the campaign.

PERATION:

SKILLS COMPETITION FORMAT:

Participants will hit three drives on a 40-yard wide grid and will **DRIVE** score a number of points based on the length of each drive. The ball must come to rest within the grid to receive points.

CHIP

Participants will hit three chips at a scoring hole. All chips will be measured from the center of the hole with scoring rings marked in 2-foot increments. The closer a ball is to the hole, the more points are received.

PUTT

Participants will attempt one putt from each distance (6', 15', and 30'). All putts will be measured from the center of the hole with scoring rings marked in 1-foot increments. The closer a ball is to the hole, the more points are received.

SCORING FORMAT:

GRADUATE

PGA HOPE graduates will hit 3 shots at each skill (DCP) and accumulate a total number of points.

We will take the highest score on one attempt for **TEAM** each Graduate and combine that as their team score for that skill.
