On the National level Kelly currently sits on the PGA Jr League committee and is also a part of the National rules committee for the past 3 years now. The Twin Lakes Golf & Swim Club has hosted the local quallifier for Drive, Chip, Putt over the past few years. Kelly has also been honored to have been the chair of the Growth of the Game committee in the Michigan Section for the past two years working with a great group of committee members and also a great staff member in the Michigan Section, Madison Maurier.

Please describe your involvement and significant leadership contributions through mentoring and sharing with other PGA of America Professionals about Youth Player Development and Growing the Game in 250 words or less:

Kelly has been a member of the Michigan Section for 20 years now and has coached junior league teams for the past 10 years at various facilities in Michigan and Ohio. She has been an All Star coach for the past 7 years. Her 17U and 13U programs annually bring around 80 juniors to the facility to participate in the program and Kelly will bring a 13U and 17U team to the Section Championship annually. In 2022 and 2023 by successfully playing in Regional Play Days Kelly's teams have advanced to the Regional PGA Jr League Championships for a chance to try and advance to Nationals. The players got to experience some great golf and play teams from other states. Kelly has also been a promoter of PGA Family Golf and at the end of each PGA Jr League season her awards night is combined with a Family Golf 9-hole event to culminate the season.

Kelly has been a huge promoter of Drive, Chip, Putt in the local community and has had many students on an annual basis go through the Local level and even the Sub-Regional level. This past summer she had the opportunity to take her son Leo Kuhlman on his journey to Valhalla in KY to the Regional level and place 8th overall in his age group.

Kelly has her Coaches ADM certification and has been awarded the Game Changer Award in recent years. She has also been the recipient of the Michigan Section PGA Youth Player Development Grant since 2018 using the grant funds to better her junior programs with US kids golf clubs, SNAG sets, and or training aids to help make the kids enjoy golf even more in practices.
