Statement of Purpose: *

What is the purpose of the program and what Growth of the Game barriers does it address? Is this program new or ongoing at your facility? What makes your program unique from others in your community?

Our PGA Junior League program has been in existence since 2017 and we have steadily built a following of players and families with our program. It has created a great community and now that we have settled into our space at Whole Golf, we want to continue the success with our program through both indoor and outdoor opportunities.

Recently, we have built a relationship with The First Tee of Greater Detroit (FTGD) and we wanted to find a way to help in their mission of building successful and confident young men and women through the game of golf. One of those ways, we felt, was through our PGA Jr. League program via scholarships from the Michigan PGA REACH grant program.

Our goal would be to offer three PGA Jr. League scholarships to three First Tee of Greater Detroit participants who are eager to continue their golf journey and build on their skills. With a desire to offer these scholarships each year, we look at this as a small component to a larger goal of building a strong golf foundation in the Bloomfield Twp/Pontiac area through our connection with The First Tee of Greater Detroit.

With our PGA Jr. League scholarship program, we hope to connect with young men and women who are currently participants in The First Tee of Greater Detroit's program and who reside in or around the city of Pontiac.
