## Michigan PGA Registered Associate/ PGA Golf Management University Student Playing Privileges Policy

**Registered Associates:** must be eligibly employed and in good standing.

### **Enrolled as a PGA Golf Management University Student**

**Meeting Requirement (Registered Associates Only):** Fall through Spring Preceding Tournament Season

To obtain Playing Privileges for the Michigan PGA Tournament Season (Section/Chapter Events), ALL Michigan PGA Registered Associates must fulfill the following requirements set forth by the Michigan PGA Officers and Board of Directors:

- Attend at least One (1) Section or Chapter Meeting (Fall and/or Spring) – Immediately Preceding Tournament Season

### **Example:**

- Attend a **Spring meeting** to earn playing privileges for the **current year**.
- Attend a **Fall meeting** to earn playing privileges for the **following year**.
- If a Spring meeting was **not** attended, you must attend a **Fall meeting** to be eligible for the **current season** and then attend a **Spring meeting** to be eligible for the **next season**.

**NOTE:** Those Registered Associates that transfer into the Section or become a Registered Associate after the Section Fall Annual Meeting will be awarded ONE grace period season and could obtain playing privileges their first season. However, the Registered Associate must attend meetings as outlined above to play going forward.

**Appeals:** Appeals shall be to the Tournament Committee Chairperson (or his/her designee). Such appeal may be in writing or oral. Such appeal shall be received by the Tournament Committee Chair no later than thirty (30) days prior to the event the Registered Associate would like to play in. The Tournament Committee Chair shall render the decision on appeal in writing within thirty (30) days of the receipt of the appeal and submit a final report to the Section Executive Director.

**The above criteria must be met each year to obtain a playing permit.**
